MEISNER & MAMET Sanford Meisner came from the Hollywood actors' influential Group Theatre, USA. Learning realistic acting technique is invaluable for the actor. Mamet's students wrote, "A Practical Handbook for the Actor," a vitally important book on how to act: we'll study it. Important elements such as script analysis and how to act truthfully under imaginary circumstances will be taught.

COMMEDIA DELL'ARTE: Considered to be one of the greatest theatrical art forms of all time; it began in 16th century Italy. Through the body, archetypal characters, such as the old man and perky maid, the stupid clown and the elitist learned doctor, scenes are improvised with defined physicalities.

IMPROVISATION: (Keith Johnstone, Impro, 2007): The ability to improvise scenes is essential for the aspiring actor. In this unit you'll learn the keys to improvisation including the following: status, reincorporation, accepting offers and the essentials of narrative.

STUDENTS WILL DO A FINAL PERFORMANCE AT THE END OF THE YEAR
