Do you want to study abroad? Would you like to study in English? Are you interested in incorporating resources in English in your future studies?

The seminar is built on the assumption that **English is a tool** to deepen your knowledge, to process information and present it efficiently - both in writing and speaking.

The seminar is centered on **complex analyses of diverse contemporary topics from humanities requiring application of lenses from various fields of expertise**: for example, poverty can be perceived through social, economic, but also political science or ethical perspective.

Contents:

In the seminar, students will learn how to approach various topics from multiple perspectives.

Students will become acquainted with how to work with **internet sources and how to cite and quote** properly.

Students will be encouraged to improve their presentation skills and work in teams.

Students will be motivated to learn to manage their time and to be the masters of their learning.

Students will explore a topic of their choice, ideally with relevance to their future academic careers.

Requirements:

Students must be on **B2** level of their language competence and be able and willing to **read academic articles in English**.

Students make the seminar so active participation and individual home preparation for the seminar is a key - searching for information and reading assigned extracts so that they could meaningfully contribute. Students must be willing to be valuable members of their teams.

There will be a group presentation (20 minutes in total) and a seminary work consisting of 5 pages in which students will explore their own topic.
